Introduction: Growing up our parents and family members give us advice.

- Our friends give us advice.
- Our doctors give us advice.
- Pastors and teachers give us advice.

Somewhere in my late teens my father gave me some good advice. He told me that in life I would need three things.

1. He told me that I would need to know the postmaster because the postmaster knew a lot of people.
2. He told me that I would need to know the bank president because one day I would need to borrow some money.
3. He told me that I would need to know a good lawyer to help me with legal things.

My father did not give much advice, but when he did, I listened. He was more into giving instructions.

Years ago, someone and I am not sure who it was, gave me some advice that has really helped me. The advice was to have some daily Bible verses to read and think about each morning before my Bible reading and prayer time.

- Today, I want to share the verses with you.
- I read them each morning and think about them as they related to me and to the day ahead before I actually begin my Bible reading and prayer time.

MY 10 Verses:

2. Psalm 119:18
3. Psalm 119:105
4. Psalm 16:8

5. Psalm 19:14
6. Psalm 86:11
7. Philippians 4:6-7
8. Philippians 4:19
9. Romans 8:28

Conclusion: As you leave today, these verses are on a bookmark on tables. You may have some family and friends to share them with. If all the verses are too many then start with the first three and add one each day. Thinking how the verses apply to your life is as important as reading the verses. It takes time, but it is time well invested.
